Digital Online Whiteboard App

[Microsoft Whiteboard](#) provides a real-time, free-form digital canvas for students and teachers to share ideas, content, text, and digital ink across devices.

In the Classroom (Grades K–12)

- Communicate, collaborate, and plan a project more effectively in real time on a digital whiteboard.

Site Features

- This is an Office 365 application.
- Whiteboards are saved automatically in the cloud.
- Boards can be exported directly to Class Notebooks (OneNote).
- Teachers can use education-themed stickers for poll responses.
- “Ink Beautification” analyzes readability of quick notes and replaces writing with legible strokes.
- “Ink Grab” can convert analog pictures of notes into digital ink.

Getting Started

1. Download Microsoft Whiteboard from the Microsoft Store.
2. Using the Whiteboard web app will require your school district to have it enabled in Office 365.
3. Sign in using the Office 365 login.
4. Use the app to create and engage in real time.
