

### Day 4 - Facilitator's Tips

1. At this stage, students are ready to get some user feedback. Suggest that they get their first round of feedback from people at home (family), then extend it to friends via phone call or email.
2. As they are finishing with their prototype, they may encounter some last-minute failures: ask them not to give up. Make sure they understand that failure is part of invention. Many people succeed only after going through many trials.
3. Once the students get the user feedback, ask them to tabulate and analyze the data using the template.
4. Have the students go through the comments and decide on which ones they are considering immediately, which comments they will consider later, and which ones are not relevant.
5. Encourage them to look at the feedback positively.
