[WeVideo](#) is an online video editor and app that allows users to create, edit, and share video content. Because WeVideo is cloud-based, it can be accessed and used from many different devices, including Chromebooks. In addition, students can work collaboratively on the same project from different locations. WeVideo is great for green screen projects, podcasts, and much more. It can be used in grades 3 through 12.

In the Classroom (Grades 3–12)

- Teachers can create a free trial account. Student accounts can be created at a cost.
- Students can use WeVideo to creatively communicate their understanding of any subject in the form of a podcast, video, screen recording, or green screen production.
- Students can use the cloud-based program to work independently or collaboratively with a group and share final projects easily.

Site Features

- WeVideo includes a teacher dashboard, where users can be added or monitored and shared settings can be controlled.
- There is a lot of built-in stock content that can be used free of copyright.
- No software needs be installed, so WeVideo can be used on most devices that have an internet connection. The WeVideo app is available on Apple and Android devices.
- Projects can be exported to and accessed within Canvas, Google Classroom, and Schoology.

Getting Started

1. Go to <https://www.wevideo.com> and click on “Learn More” under the “Education” section. Click on the “Educators, Try WeVideo” button and create a free trial account.
2. You can create an account using a school Google or Microsoft account. You can also sign up with an email address.
3. Click on your dashboard to view content.
