Digital Book Making

Students and teachers can create beautiful multimedia digital books with **Book Creator**. Book Creator is an easy to use tool where students can create a digital book together or independently to share with the class. Following the site's prompts, you can add video, text, images, and audio to your book. When finished, books can be published and shared.

## In the Classroom (Grades K–12)

- Have students create books during their publishing stage of writing.
- Students can combine books to create a class set.
- Create books as a class and add images and ideas based on your students' suggestions.
- Teacher can create books and add a recording of students reading the book, so developing readers can still access the content.
- Use in a flipped classroom to deliver course materials.
- Assign several student groups a different topic and enhance their learning by having each group create their own multimedia versions as they learn more about the topic.
- Deepen student learning by having students add additional material to a class book or a book created by another student or group of students.

## This site has the following features:

- Parent permission is advised before posting student work created using this tool.
- Requires registration/login (with email).
- Products can be embedded.
- Products can be shared by URL.
- There is a free and premium (paid) version.
- Currently, Book Creator only works in Chrome and on iPads.
