

Kahoot! Online Assessment

<u>Kahoot!</u> is a free online assessment tool that allows you to build instant polls, quizzes, or responses through a simple drag and drop interface. Find ready-made quizzes on the public Kahoot! menu by entering search terms. Kahoot! also has a team option. Groups can use one computer to answer questions. The teacher gets the data back instantly, and it is stored on the site or can be downloaded. There is also a ghost option that allows students to take the Kahoot! again and try to better their score.

In the Classroom (Grades K–12)

- Create pretests to offer to gifted students to "test out" of already learned material.
- Use this tool often to obtain a snapshot of each student's understanding of content.
- Another tip is to freeze your screen to be able to view the nicknames that students choose in order to prevent inappropriate selections.

This site has the following features:

- Includes an education-only area for teachers and students.
- Requires registration/log-in (WITH email).
- Products can be shared by URL.
- Includes teacher tools for registering and/or monitoring students.
