An Online Photo Editing Tool

[Pixlr](#) is a free online photo editor. There are two versions of the editor available online: X and E. The X version is described as “the easy to use photo editor.” It features a simpler interface and is a great choice for those who are just getting started or looking for basic image editing tools. Pixlr E is described as a “powerful photo editor for pros” and contains more features and an interface that emulates Adobe Photoshop. A third option is a tool that intelligently removes an image background. Because these tools all fall under the Pixlr brand, you can switch between programs quickly and seamlessly. While there is a premium version available, it is not necessary for most projects. In fact, you do not even need to set up an account to use any of these Pixlr editors.
